Emergency Preparedness Discussion Guide

Watching the *Danger Rangers* is an experience the entire family can enjoy together. Here's a few key points you can review with your child before watching "Be Prepared".



1. Review the different types of emergencies that could occur in your area and how your family is preparing for them. For example, do you have an emergency kit in your home?
2. Identify the rooms in the house without windows, such as a bathroom or basement, where your family should go during a hurricane or tornado.
3. Review your family's escape plan and make sure your children know what to do if the smoke alarm or carbon monoxide detector goes off. Practice two escape routes from each room.
4. Show your children where you keep your first aid kit and how to use basic first aid supplies.

Let's see how much you've learned after watching "Be Prepared"!

1. What are some examples of emergencies that you need to be ready for?
