



# Play It Safe!

**If you find something and you're not sure what it is, remember these safety tips:**

- Pills are NOT candy. If you find a pill, give it to an adult!
- Only take medicine from an adult you trust.
- If you are unsure if something is safe to eat, ask first. Only an adult can tell if something is safe to touch or eat.
- Never touch your parent's medication.
- Never eat plants, flowers, berries and mushrooms when playing outside. They could make you sick.
- Store food and poisons, such as medicine and cleaners, separately.
- Call Poison Control (1-800-222-1222) immediately if someone has swallowed something harmful.
